Burgess Norton (BN) is committed to protecting the personal information that you provide to us when using any BN website page. This Privacy Policy describes the types of information we collect from you when you visit a BN website page and how we use the information. Automatically-Collected Information

BN measures traffic on various website pages so that we can evaluate user needs and improve the types of the information we offer. Traffic analysis is performed using information which is automatically received from you when you visit a BN website page, such as the Internet protocol (IP) address of the computer you use, the type of web browser software you use, the date and time you access each page, etc.

Cookie Information

Cookies are small, locally-stored data files created by your web browser at the direction of certain website pages. BN uses cookies to simplify or eliminate data entry for you on a future visit to one of our website pages. The BN website pages will function even if you set your web browser to refuse cookies, although your overall browsing experience could suffer as you may be re-prompted for information that you previously provided.

Submitted Personal Information

BN does not share, rent, trade, or sell to unrelated third parties any of the personal information you provide. Your personal information may be shared with factory-authorized BN sales representatives. Our representatives will only use this information to contact you regarding BN business. Sending data over the Internet is never completely secure. Although we take reasonable steps to protect your information when it is in our possession, we cannot guarantee the security of the information during transmission, and any information you send is sent at your own risk.
